INJURY: LATERAL LUXATION



DEFINITION OF LATERAL LUXATION



Displacement of the tooth other than axially. This is accompanied by comminution or fracture of the alveolar socket









TREATMENT

- Repositioning + splinting



TREATMENT PLAN

4 weeks : Clinical and radiographic control
+ splint removal

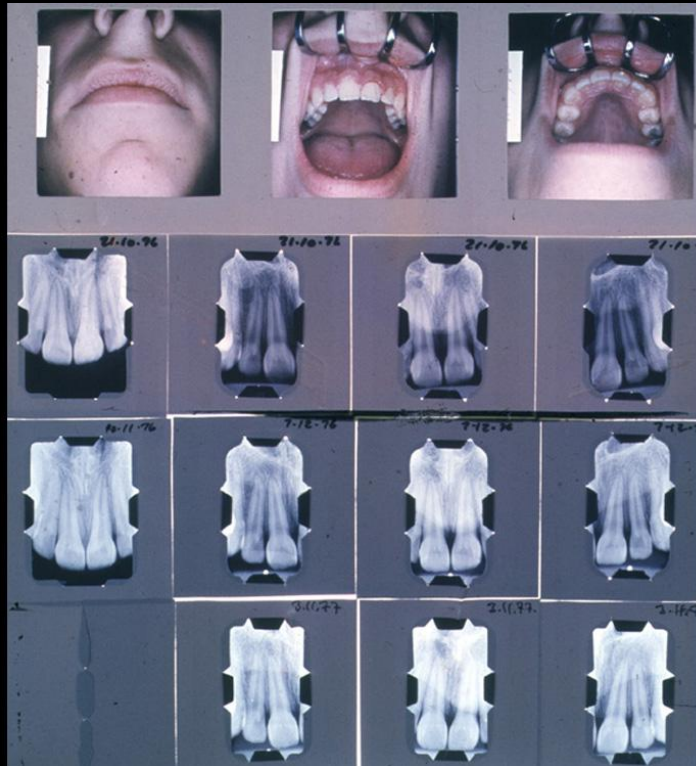
8 weeks : Clinical and radiographic control

6 months : Clinical and radiographic control

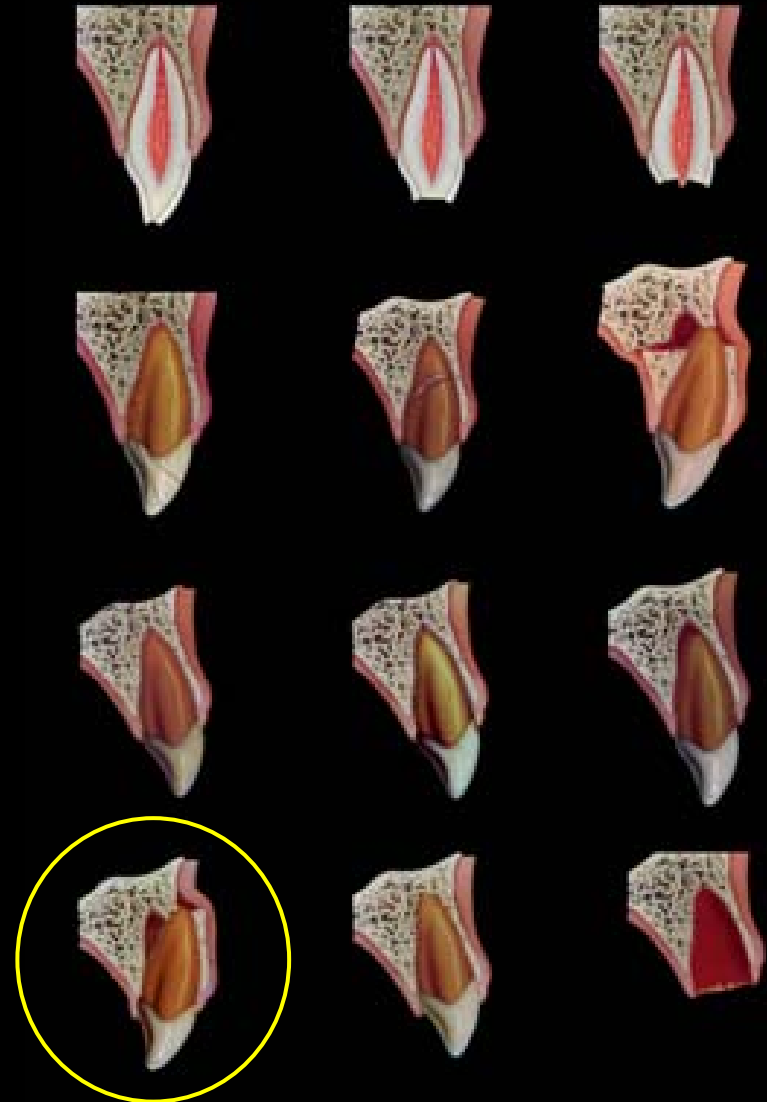
12 months : Clinical and radiographic control

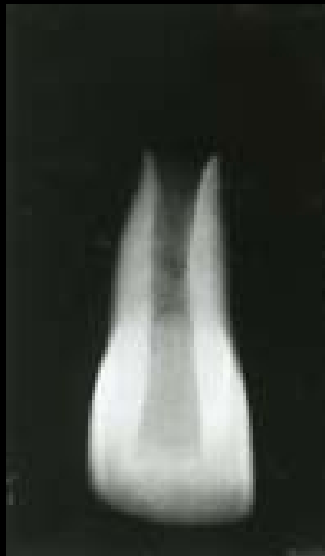

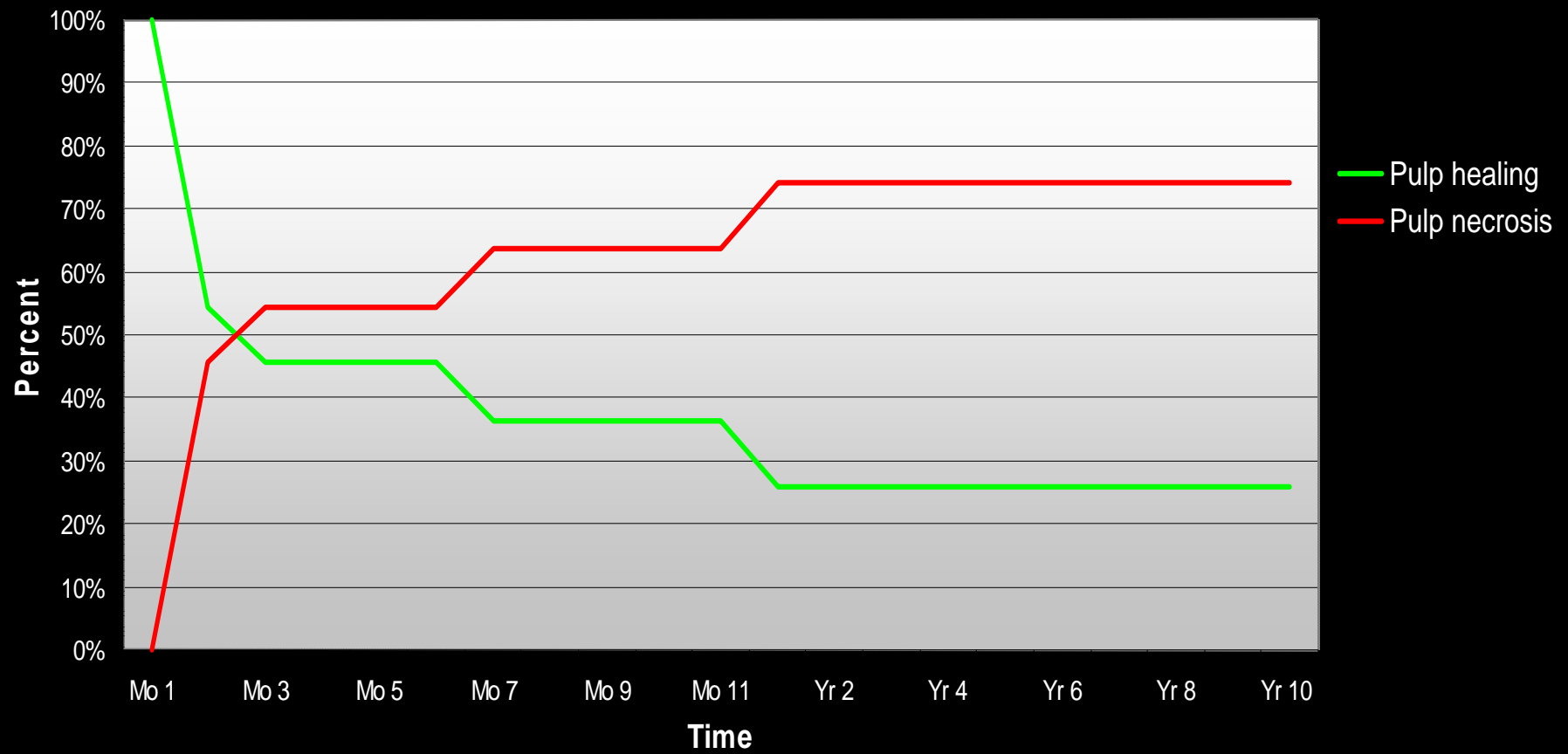
